Welcome back for the Summer Term.

This is the critical term in the year when we complete the studies for the year and pupils secure their learning in preparation for the next year.

Assessment is critical in this term and we aim for the most accurate reporting of where each child is up to in terms of attainment and progress. Year 2 and year 6 children complete the National SATs tests during the month of May and in June, Year 6 complete the writing exercises for the SATs tests.



All the children in the other year groups are assessed and given results in terms of their attainment and progress and this is used to identify any gaps in their learning and address those gaps as they proceed to the next year of study.

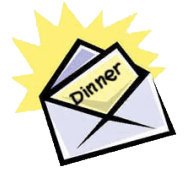
