## EARLHAM ELECTION 2017



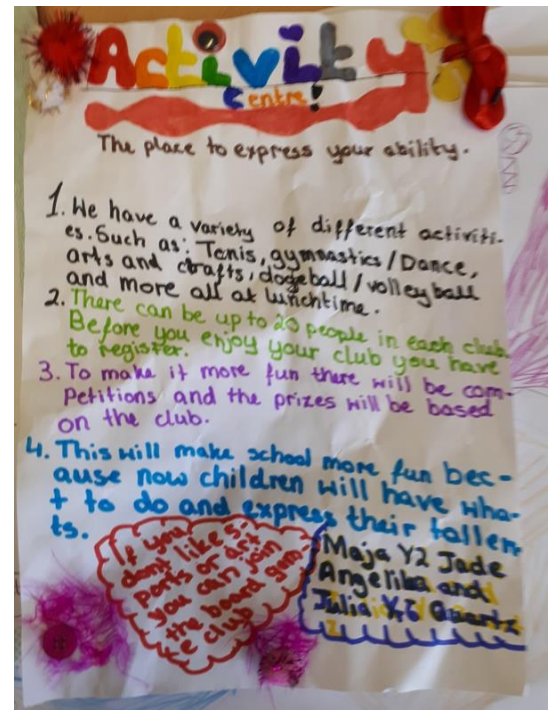
