# **Opal/ Pearl**

The Romans

## **Maths**

This term we will be focusing on number: place value, ordering and comparing different numbers up to 4 digits, counting backwards through zero into negative numbers, addition and subtraction, multiplying by 10, 100 and 1000 and word problems.

Children should be revising their times tables at home <u>EVERY DAY</u>.

## **English**

This term we will be looking at stories with historical settings (cross curricular with our topic of the Romans) and newspaper reports.

Children should be reading for at least 15 minutes <u>EVERY DAY</u> with an adult.

### Computing

We will be following a brand new Computing programme called 'Coding' in which the children will be learning to understand and use algorithms

#### Science

We will be investigating Animals Including Humans. This will include investigating the human digestive system and teeth and visits to Sec. Schools.

# RE

We will be learning about most of the major faiths practiced in the UK and beyond.

#### Music

In Year 4, the children will receive either string instrument e.g.(violin)/wind instruments, e.g. trumpet or clarinet music lessons.

Homework will be given on line at the school website as already discussed in previous letters to you. If you haven't yet downloaded the app, please do to be able to access and help with your child's homework.
