Africa: Benin

Maths

This term we will be solving problems using the four operations: Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division with a focus on using formal written methods to solve multiplication and division problems. We are also going to be focusing on rapid recall of times tables.

English/ Reading

This term we will be focusing on spelling, punctuation and grammar. We will also be working on using a dictionary to find word definitions and using a thesaurus to find synonyms and antonyms.

Children should be reading for at least 15 minutes **EVERY DAY** with an adult.

Computing

We will be programming using 'Scratch' and also researching for information relating to our topics.

Science

We will be learning about Animals Including Humans. The children will learn about the circulatory system and how the body works.

Homework

Homework will be given out on Thursdays and it will consist of reinforcement activities regarding English and Maths. The homework can be found on the new Earlham App.

Geography/ History

We will be learning about Africa and in particular the Benin Empire. Children will learn about how the empire was built and factors that led to its demise.

RE

We will be learning the importance of what it means to belong to a religion. We will also be looking at religious traditions around the world.

We will be looking at bullying and ways to build friendships. Children will be working on defining bullying and also finding ways to resolve conflicts.
