Learn new words in English and home language to support thinking and learning.



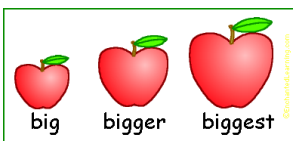
Maths

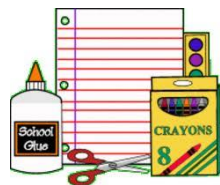
Curriculum planning
