Have a conversation about something that interests you.



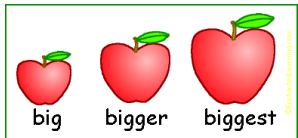
Maths

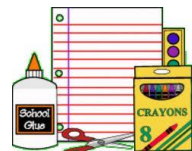
