Whilst I understand that in the vast majority of cases, there is a genuine family reason because nearly all of our Earlham families have their extended family not in London, it is really disruptive to the learning and holds our school back. Please realise that every day that you get your child to school on time, it promotes our whole school and helps us move forward on our continued journey of progress and success. Together, we are building our future through our children at the school and we do need to work together, with everyone doing their bit by getting to school every day. Currently we are on 94.2% for the whole year since September and we need everybody to raise their attendance game to get to at least 95%. We have re-started our weekly 100% attendance raffle and will be looking to promote attendance this term.

We were visited by builders this week as they bid for the tender to build our brand new school which will hopefully be built during 2019. It will be a carefully planned project so that disruption will be as little as possible and the outcome will be a brand-new effective and efficient building for our children to enjoy.
