*Ancient Greece*

**Maths**

This term we will be revising all areas covered this academic year in preparation for SATs. Maths homework will be set using 'Mathletics' and children should continue to revise using the revision guides purchased at the beginning of the academic year.

Children should be revising their times tables at home **EVERY DAY**.

**English/ Reading**

This term we will be focusing on SPAG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar) in preparation for SATs. We will also look at assessing and editing work using the assessment framework. English homework tasks will be set using 'Literacy Planet'.

This term's Computing topic is 'How the internet works'. There will also be a focus on 'Literacy Planet' activities and 'Mathletics'.

**Science**

**Homework**

Homework will be given out on Thursdays and it will consist of reinforcement activities regarding English and Maths. English homework will now be assigned through 'Literacy Planet' and Maths will be assigned through 'Mathletics'.

**Geography/ History**

We will be continuing to learn about Ancient Greece. We will learn about its colonies, gods, landmarks and create timelines of historical events and Ancient Greek figures.
