Opal/ Pearl

Coasts

Maths

This term we will be focusing on

number: Multiplication / division

- Time – digital and analogue
- Position and direction
- Decimals
- Measurement – length, capacity
- Statistics

Children should be revising their times tables at home **EVERY DAY**.

English

This term we will be looking at **Non-chronological reports, learning how to make notes, setting descriptions and writing Biographies and autobiographies.**

Children should be reading for at least 15 minutes **EVERY DAY** with an adult.

Computing

This term children will continue to learn basic coding skills and computational thinking using SCRATCH: A program from MIT that lets kids create games and animations without learning programming text—it's a drag-and-drop way to learn computer concepts and have fun.

We will also be developing on our word processing skills.

Science

We will be focussing on 'Electricity'
We will create simple circuits and also create an awareness of dangers around the use of electricity.

Homework

Homework will be given on line at the school website as already discussed in previous letters to you. If you haven't yet downloaded the app, please do to be able to access and help with your child's homework.

Geography/ History

We will be learning about Coasts. We will be using our previous knowledge about the water cycle to investigate coasts, coastal animals and coastal food chains.

RE

We will be learning about most of the major faiths practiced in the UK and beyond. Focus: Hinduism (Belonging to a religion)

PSHE/ Philosophy

We will be focussing on relationships. We will be looking at relationships in and out of school. (family, friends)
Embracing diversity.

PE

P.E is on Mondays and Fridays for Pearl class and Tuesday and Wednesday for Opal class.

Music

In Year 4, the children will receive either string instruments like the guitar or violin and wind instruments, e.g. trumpet or clarinet music lessons.
