Dear Parents and Carers,

Our school nurse, Jennifer Roberts, will be leading a session for parents and carers on Wednesday morning to explain the services and support that the school nursing team can provide.

Every school has a school nurse attached to them . The school nurse can help parents and carers if they have a concern about their child's development. for example their growth, weight, toileting, medications or their emotional development. They are responsible for telling the school when a child has been identified as having a medical condition which will require support in school. Wherever possible, they do this before the child starts at the school.

A school nurse may support staff in writing a child's individual healthcare plan, and also provide advice and liaison, for example on training school staff. School nurses can liaise with consultant Paediatricians and other specialist staff on appropriate support for children and associated staff training needs.

If you have any concerns regarding your child's health / development or would like to find out more about the School Nursing Service, please attend the session.
