Re New Build Update

I am delighted to be able to update you with some positive news about our new school build. As you are aware, the work was unfortunately delayed meaning that the original move date was put on hold.

I am now in a position to confirm that all being well, we will officially move into the new building in early September. As I am sure you can appreciate, there is a great deal to organise over the next few weeks.

I also have some extremely good news to share with you regarding the fence and gates that surround the school. One of my priorities since joining Earlham has been to have these replaced for the greater safety and security of the whole school community.

I am thrilled to be able to tell you that in addition to the new school building, our school will have a whole new fencing installation in place for the autumn term.

This is a major achievement for the school as these works were not included as part of the new school build programme. I have worked closely with the local authority who have been extremely supportive and recognised the need to keep everyone safe.

Please note that this means as a result of these works, the children will now be returning to school at the slightly later date of 7th September.
